Dear Sir/Madam,

Amendments to the Guideline on Information Required for Determining and Paying Compensation (IS Guideline) and Revised Compliance Review Program for the IS Guideline

The Deposit Protection Scheme (Amendment) Ordinance 2016 gazetted on 24 March 2016 adopts a gross approach for compensation determination when the Deposit Protection Scheme (DPS) is triggered. In connection to this, the data requirement related to customer liabilities set out in the IS Guideline issued by the Hong Kong Deposit Protection Board (the Board) under section 8(1) of the DPS Ordinance becomes irrelevant.

I am writing to inform you that, following consultations with the Hong Kong Association of Banks, the Board has finalised the amendments to the IS Guideline (Enclosure 1(a)), the Explanatory Note to the IS Guideline (Enclosure 1(b)), the Compliance Review Program for the IS Guideline (Enclosure 2) and the Program Guide on Independent Assessment Program (Enclosure 3). The revised IS Guideline and the Explanatory Note will be gazetted in May 2016.

Scheme members are required to complete enhancements to their systems and records to achieve compliance with the revised guideline before the end of July 2016. For the avoidance of doubt, Scheme members should continue to comply with the requirements set out in the 2013 Guideline until they meet compliance with the revised guideline. The Board will adopt the revised Compliance Review Program commencing May 2016 when undertaking compliance checks.
